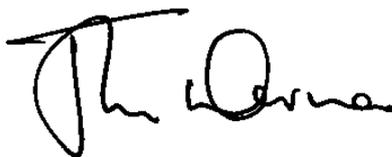

Quality objectives are set and reviewed as per the procedure in the quality manual. Generally overall quality objectives are normally set as a function of the management review. They are then disseminated by departmental managers to individual functions and persons. They are reviewed at regular intervals to ensure progress.

The Management Representative is the Quality Manager who has my full authority and the responsibility for implementing and taking forward new quality measures as well as maintaining our current quality management system. It is a mandatory condition of employment that all personnel follow the agreed procedures in maintaining the highest levels of quality at all times.

This Policy will be reviewed and updated if necessary at our regular Management Meetings, and at least annually at the QMS Management Review Meeting.
